equipment? and b) Is the Bureau allowed to purchase <u>Title III digital collection</u> equipment that is not a component of the DCS 3000 (or whatever is the current moniker for the olympia ystem)?
I told him that I was pretty sure that the FBI had no proprietary interest over a Hewlett Packard Magneto Optical Jukebox, and I know that JSI is selling collection systems formerly used by the Bureau to state and local law enforcement agencies around the country. However, I am not so sure about procurement rules regarding the purchase of non-DCS collection equipment. I am not a computer systems expert, but I think an MO jukebox is a pretty standard peripheral device, which possibly could be integrated into any digital collection system with the right software.
The goal here is to help the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office upgrade their system for the benefit of the entire HIDTA task force of which Sacramento FBI is a member. The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office is the lead agency in this task force, and Sacramento FBI would benefit from its purchase. Can we get your concurrence for Sacramento to make this purchase? The funding is available through OCDETF, and Sacramento qualifies for this funding by participating in OCDETF investigations.
I am also faxing you a copy of the price quote given to the Sacramento County Sheriff's Office from Penlink, Ltd. for the system upgrade. The Sacramento County Sheriff's Office has arranged alternative funding for the rest of the upgrade, except for the MO Jukebox. Please e-mail me or call me back regarding this issue.

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



Hal asked me to review the below thread and make a recommendation. After discussing with here's what we came up with	
First, based on my recollection, the Voicebox is a portable system, but not necessarily a laptop. Second, since this Voicebox is NOT an FBI system that is being connected to a FBI system, it deserves some scrutiny from security, which I am sure that you have already done. We are assuming that this scenario may repeat itself in the future. Therefore, we feel that it would be appropriate for there to be a written operating procedure (most likely a page or two at most) that describes the following: 1) the Voicebox while attached to DCS 3000 will be under FBI control, 2) that appropriate safeguards are in place (listing safeguards), and 3) describing the sanitization process for ensuring that FBI data/information is not falling into the wrong hands when the Voicebox is removed from DCS 3000.	
Once this is written and you review to ensure that it is adequate, we would ask that you please provide a copy of the operating procedure to the Accreditation Unit, so we can place it in the DCS 3000 C&A file for future reference. It would be the basis for future and similar request to do the same.	
We did something similar to this (somewhat different circumstances) about 18 months ago involving a HIDTA operation in Denver. We agree that there is nothing here (at least on the surface) that would require any accreditation impact. We would just like it documented in the C&A file.

This requests the assistance of the "To" addressees to meet a short-fused, very high-visibility DOJ tasking that the FBI received yesterday. The tasking relates to requirements by DOJ (passing down requirements by OMB) that agencies must on a quarterly basis certify 90% completion (for all FBI systems) of Privacy Impact Assessments (PIAs) required by Section 208 of the E-Government Act (E-Gov). To meet the two deadlines imposed by DOJ, we will need completed inputs by affected divisions by 6/9 and 6/21, as described below.

The FBI has been doing our own PIAs for years, and we have known about the changes looming under E-Gov for many months. We have, however, been long awaiting specific implementation guidance from DOJ, which has only just moved to resolution with the very recent arrival and identification/assumption of responsibilities of DOJ's new Chief Privacy and Civil Liberties Officer (Jane Horvath). This culminated in the 5/30/2006 DAG memo which we received yesterday (TRIM 06/DO/3020) directing the FBI to focus on the 28 FBI Law Enforcement systems on the FBI's 2006 FISMA inventory (see attached).

1) RE: The DCS-5000/DCS-6000 request - DTP requests 14 new positions. We are concerned that external oversight from DOJ and OMB is going to question so many new positions. Why are so many additional positions required especially given the fact that the program is seeing a diminishing trend in the number of systems deployed. We understand that those systems in the FY2001/2002 timeframe are near the end of their life cycle and will need to be replaced but oversight might say replacing a system should be no more difficult than installing one.

There has been a heavy reliance on contractor support since the initiation of this project. While the benefits of being able to hire specific, technical expertise as required has proved to be efficient, a hard lesson learned is that contracted support is only as good as the funding stream that supports it. Since FY2003, base funding for TICTU has decreased from \$41.02M to \$26.09M due to permanent rescissions, realignments, and reallocations. Concurrent with the decrease in funding was a significant increase in the number of systems requiring deployment, upgrade, and

maintenance - 126 Title 50, 97 Title III systems, and 56 DCS-3000s. Although the number of systems has decreased since the initial deployments, the desired government-provided workload required to support them has never been reached - hence the reliance on contractor support. The primary maintenance capability that provides on-site field support, provided by the Dedicated Contractor Support Program (DCSP), is scheduled to be downsized by 30+ personnel in FY 2007. TICTU must continue to supplement field assets with maintenance capabilities to sustain collection capabilities. This supplement is best provided by government personnel who are a more stable and costeffective resource. TICTU requires the additional personnel to ensure that the effacacy (reliability, availability, and maintainability) of digital collection capability is not diminished, as well as, ensuring that the FBI is on sure footing with the right skill sets to migrate to the next generation on digital collection systems, i.e., regionalization.
