## Intelligence Oversight Board EPIC Releases

- I. On October 24, 2005, the Washington Post published an article titled, "FBI Papers Indicate Intelligence Violations." The article reports on 13 reports to the Intelligence Oversight Board (IOB) that were made by the FBI during Fiscal Years 2003 and 2004, that had been disclosed to the Electronic Privacy Information Center (EPIC), an advocacy group in response to a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records relating to the Patriot Act.
  - A. The specifics of the IOB reports that were released to EPIC in response to a FOIA request are as follows:
    - 1. the majority involved purely administrative errors (overrunning a preliminary investigation (PI), failing to submit a timely annual report)
    - 2. only five involved more substantive errors (carrier errors, obtaining financial documents without prior approval).
  - B. On December 30, 2005, an additional seven IOB reports were released in response to a FOIA request.
- II. Establishment of the Intelligence Oversight Board
  - A. The President, by Executive Order 12334 of December 4, 1981, established the President's Intelligence Oversight Board. On September 13, 1993, by Executive Order 12863, the President renamed it the Intelligence Oversight Board and established the Board as a standing committee of the President's Foreign Intelligence Advisory Board. The IOB has been given the authority to review the FBI's practices and procedures relating to foreign intelligence and foreign counterintelligence collection.
  - B. The FBI, as a member of the Intelligence Community, is obligated to report violations of the Constitution, laws, executive orders, and Presidential Directives to the IOB. This includes violations of agency procedures if such provisions were intended to protect the individual rights of a US person.
- III. FBI Reporting Procedures for Possible IOB Violations
  - A. All FBI employees have an obligation to report potential IOB matters to

the Office of the General Counsel (OGC) and the Inspection Division within 14 days of discovery of the potential error or violation. In addition to the foregoing, on a quarterly basis, each field office and FBI Headquarters division is required to submit to OGC a document certifying that all employees of the office or division were contacted concerning the requirement to report potential IOB matters.

- B. OGC reviews the reports to determine if the potential error or violation requires notification to the IOB. If OGC determines that the reported matter requires notification to the IOB, OGC prepares the necessary correspondence to the IOB setting forth the basis of the notification. OGC will also notify the Office of Intelligence Policy and Review (OIPR) and the FBI's Inspection Division.
- C. The FBI's Inspection Division is responsible for reviewing the potential violations to determine whether any discipline should be taken against the employee and for detecting trends of violations that should be addressed systematically.
- D. If the IOB violation involves the unintentional acquisition of information under the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act (FISA), that information is sequestered with OIPR for eventual destruction by order the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court pursuant to Section 106(i) of the Act. If the IOB violation involves the unintentional acquisition of information unrelated to a FISA court order, the FBI will take appropriate remedial action and take steps to obtain the information correctly.
- E. OIPR reports FISA violations to the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court and to Congress.
- F. The FBI takes all reports of possible IOB violations seriously and has a comprehensive process for reporting, conducting legal reviews, and referring violations to the Intelligence Oversight Board, Office of Intelligence Policy and Review and Congress.


