- 1.2 The FBI has a mandate from Congress, the President, the Attorney General, and the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) to produce intelligence in support of its own investigative mission, national intelligence priorities, and the needs of other intelligence consumers. The FBI serves a considerable customer base, ranging from its own investigators and executives, to other United States (US) Government departments, state, local, and tribal law enforcement, and the general public. 


