

I am an attorney in the FBI Office of the General Counsel and have been assigned to write an IOB opinion relating to the IOB matter that you submitted to our office. The IOB matter involves excess information that was obtained in response to an NSL that was served out of your office. My initial impression is that, although you were required to report the incident to OGC, it does not appear that it will be reportable to the IOB.
