I talked to [redacted] and asked again about [redacted] It sounds like [redacted] a month for a [redacted] just [redacted] this year, but who will pay for that? This question will be relevant for other RAs as we continue to spread away from the field offices, putting linguists wherever we can.

Last year with CJIS and the moving of the [redacted] we got lucky, [redacted] says, because after months of pushing ITOD (or CJIS?) paid for the upgrade to the [redacted] site. We didn't request that move, after all.

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In this case, though, [redacted] feels that the "customer" who is benefiting from the work should pay. LSS could be that person, but it's more accurately CD and CTD.

We have Chinese and Korean linguists in [redacted] but [redacted] suggests that we go to both CTD and CD and state that the linguists nationwide support their cases and we need them to both help upgrade RAs for Red Wolf functionality. (Who's to say we won't hire an Arabic linguist in [redacted] tomorrow?)

As an additional note, per [redacted] were bought by LSS after 9/11 to pay for the upgrade of [redacted] and get all offices onto [redacted] That money is long gone, the routers are getting old and we are still expanding sites. [redacted] will be preparing some requisitions for the equipment they need to continue to support [redacted] nationwide, and will be going out asking for someone to fund them. We may be first on her list to ask.

I think [redacted] put some money in the suggested budget for 06 to handle buildouts, but i don't know if there is anything in there that speaks specifically to hardware for [redacted]

There is currently no money that OTD gets dedicated specifically to keep [redacted] equipment going [redacted] suggests that we, OTD and the DI, should push together to get ITOD and even the Director's Office to understand the great need for some money to support [redacted] that is only going to increase as time goes on. As the Director has asked Congress for more and more people, ITOD is not funding the expansion of the network to handle the growth we are going to see.

Due to a lack of [redacted] capacity, only one Red Wolf station can run at a time, and even that puts a severe strain on the RA. What is needed is a [redacted] dedicated for the Contract Linguists, which would allow both Red Wolf stations to run simultaneously, and at the same time, free up the RA. From my understanding, there is enough [redacted] work out there that should more than justify the additional [redacted]

I talked to [redacted] and asked again about [redacted]. It sounds like [redacted] a month for a [redacted] just [redacted] this year, but who will pay for that? This question will be relevant for other RAs as we continue to spread away from the field offices, putting linguists wherever we can.

Last year with CJIS and the moving of the [redacted] to [redacted] we got lucky [redacted] says, because after months of pushing ITOD (or CJIS?) paid for the upgrade to the [redacted] site. We didn't request that move, after all.

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In this case, though, [redacted] feels that the "customer" who is benefiting from the work should pay. LSS could be that person, but it's more accurately CD and CTD.

We have [redacted] linguists in [redacted] but [redacted] suggests that we go to both CTD and CD and state that the linguists nationwide support their cases and we need them to both help upgrade RAs for Red Wolf functionality. (Who's to say we won't hire an [redacted] linguist in [redacted] tomorrow?)

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As an additional note, per [redacted] were bought by LSS after 9/11 to pay for the upgrade of [redacted] and get all offices onto [redacted]. That money is long gone, the routers are getting old and we are still expanding sites. [redacted] will be preparing some requisitions for the equipment they need to continue to support [redacted] nationwide, and will be going out asking for someone to fund them. We may be first on her list to ask.

I think [redacted] put some money in the suggested budget for 06 to handle buildouts, but i don't know if there is anything in there that speaks specifically to hardware for [redacted]

There is currently no money that OTD gets dedicated specifically to keep [redacted] equipment going. [redacted] suggests that we, OTD and the DI, should push together to get ITOD and even the Director's Office to understand the great need for some money to support [redacted] that is only going to increase as time goes on. As the Director has asked Congress for more and more people, ITOD is not funding the expansion of the network to handle the growth we are going to see.
