In a recent discussion with the Office of the General Counsel, monitoring/collecting in different jurisdictions is not an issue. In U.S. v. Denman, 100 F.3d 399 (5th Cir. 1996) the court stated "(w)e agree with the reasoning of the Second Circuit and now hold that interception includes both the location of a tapped telephone and the original listening post, and that judges in either jurisdiction have authority under Title III to issue wiretap orders." The original citing for this came from U.S. v. Rodriguez 968 F.2d 130 (2d Cir. 1992). In this case, interception refers to where a communication is initially obtained regardless of where it is being heard. [redacted]

This is to clarify the requirements of the 12/20/2005 EC that was sent to all FBI divisions concerning FBI databases and a need to respond by January 13, 2006 with a description of such databases.

The EC requires descriptions of databases that are used in field offices but that are Bureau-wide, such as [redacted] Red Wolf. We have decided that a more efficient manner of obtaining the same information is to have a single description of such databases, to include [redacted] Red Wolf, [redacted] circulated among the field offices. It will be drafted here at headquarters and [redacted]. The field offices will simply need to state whether such descriptions are consistent with their particular operation and use of the database. If there are discrepancies, such discrepancies will have to be described. Hopefully, those descriptions will be circulated by the end of this week.

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There does remain the issue of access to those databases, which is particular to individual field offices. Therefore, field offices still need to respond to questions 7 through 9 of the EC, which focus upon access to the databases, and question 20, which focuses upon the audit trail.

Further, the EC requires descriptions of all databases that are unique to the field offices. That requirement still stands, and all questions with respect to such databases (1 through 20) need to be answered.

CDCs- please disseminate this to those people in your field office who have responsibility for this project. Hopefully, this will eliminate a great deal of work on their part, but will still provide a clear and concise explanation of the databases, as well as any variations in operation or use that exist through the Bureau.

III. OTHER SYSTEMS/APPLICATIONS/NETWORKS CONTAINING FISA MATERIAL

There are a number of FBI “systems/applications/networks” that contain FISA material, which are legacy systems that may be replaced by newer technology. We are listing some of the current systems and will provide additional information as requested.

A. Systems/applications/networks containing raw FISA take.

1. Red Wolf (system)

a. Description of the types of FISA information contained in Red Wolf.

~~(S)~~ Red Wolf is the vendor's name for DCS-5000, the FBI's primary FISA audio collection system. Red Wolf also collects and produces, but many sites use [redacted]. It is possible for users, such as language analysts, to perform analytical searches of FISA material collected by the system and the summary transcripts from that material. It allows real-time and off-line monitoring, as well as report generation.

~~(S)~~ Red Wolf currently is the primary collection system for audio and in some offices facsimile, and may possibly be replaced by [redacted] or another system, although this may be several years away.

b. Explanation of how access to FISA information is controlled, that is, restrictions on search and retrieval of information.

~~(S)~~ Full access to FISA audio collected through Red Wolf is generally restricted to predetermined authorized users, generally the linguists assigned to the case associated with the FISA information and their supervisors. Case Agents and the system administrator in the office where the audio is collected also have limited access. In all instances, access to the Red Wolf servers is restricted, and in many instances the Red Wolf workstations that the linguists use are in a room with restricted access.

~~(S)~~ Authorized users can search and retrieve FISA audio by Signal Related Information (date/time of call, outgoing telephone number dialed, etc.).

c. Implementation of standard minimization procedures.

~~(S)~~ Prior to accessing FISA information in Red Wolf, linguists are required to read and sign the court orders certifying that they understand the minimization guidelines applicable to each case. Currently, the Red Wolf system does not contain a FISA caveat banner similar to the one found in [redacted] DWS. Thus, NSLB will recommend that a FISA caveat banner be incorporated into Red Wolf identical to the one currently found in [redacted] DWS.
