

2 SEC. ____, DENIAL OF FEDERAL BENEFITS TO CONVICTED 3 TERRORISTS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 113B of title 18, United
5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol6 lowing:

7 "§ 2339E. Denial of Federal benefits to terrorists
8 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Any individual who is convicted
9 of a Federal crime of terrorism (as defined in section

2332b(g)) shall, as provided by the court on motion of
 the Government, be ineligible for any or all Federal bene fits for any term of years or for life.

4 "(b) FEDERAL BENEFIT DEFINED.—In this section,
5 'Federal benefit' has the meaning given that term in sec6 tion 421(d) of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
7 862(d)).".

8 (b) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections for
9 chapter 113B of title 18, United States Code, is amended
10 by adding at the end the following:

"2339D. Receiving military-type training from a foreign terrorist organization. "2339E. Denial of Federal benefits to terrorists.".
