- 2 **SEC. ____ . DENIAL OF FEDERAL BENEFITS TO CONVICTED**
- 3 **TERRORISTS.**
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 113B of title 18, United
- 5 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 6 lowing:
- 7 **“§ 2339E. Denial of Federal benefits to terrorists**
- 8 **“(a) IN GENERAL.—Any individual who is convicted**
- 9 **of a Federal crime of terrorism (as defined in section**

1 2332b(g)) shall, as provided by the court on motion of
2 the Government, be ineligible for any or all Federal bene-
3 fits for any term of years or for life.

4 “(b) FEDERAL BENEFIT DEFINED.—In this section,
5 ‘Federal benefit’ has the meaning given that term in sec-
6 tion 421(d) of the Controlled Substances Act (21 U.S.C.
7 862(d)).”.

8 (b) TABLE OF SECTIONS.—The table of sections for
9 chapter 113B of title 18, United States Code, is amended
10 by adding at the end the following:

“2339D. Receiving military-type training from a foreign terrorist organization.
“2339E. Denial of Federal benefits to terrorists.”.
