The grounds for the motion are more fully set forth in the attached Memorandum of Points and Authorities.

Defendants request that reconsideration be granted without further briefing, as the motion for leave to file a motion for reconsideration incorporates the substantive basis for the motion for reconsideration, and thus the motion for reconsideration would substantially repeat the arguments presented here.
